Tell us about yourself or your organisation

I am a volunteer for the National Osteoporosis Society since 2002 when I was diagnosed with osteoporosis.

Why are you a member of Bournemouth 2026 Trust?

To raise awareness of osteoporosis in this area. Osteoporosis affects one in two women and one in five men over the age of 50, and 300,000 fragility fractures happen a year. The fractures can be life changing and often, people will experience more than one before they are diagnosed.
